Giving of Our Means, Realizing Our Dreams

- Ecclesiastes 5:3

1 ***God causes the need to exist.***
(Matthew 16:18)

How wonderful to recognize that "God is the source!" Our church building need was brought into existence by Him for His glory.

2 ***God will never cause a need beyond His ability to supply.***
(Philippians 4:19)

As our Source, He is our provider from His supply. How thrilling to recognize that God has set His provision program into operation using man.

3 ***God's provision is through His people, usually through previous supply.***
(Exodus 36:7)

By understanding and following these three biblical principles, we enter into partnership with God as a channel bringing glory and honor to our Heavenly Father.

Phase One

The initial phase of our project will be to purchase a new sign which will include a digital, programmable display. This will enable us to directly communicate to thousands of people every week as they pass by our church on Lumpkin Road.

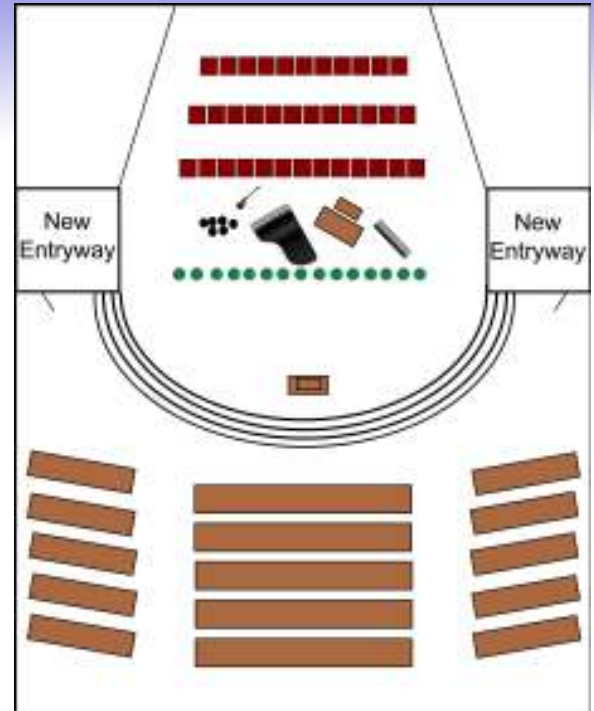
We will then landscape around the new sign and carry the new landscaping across the frontage, giving a fresh look to the properties.

The budget for this project will be \$45,000.



Phase Two & Three

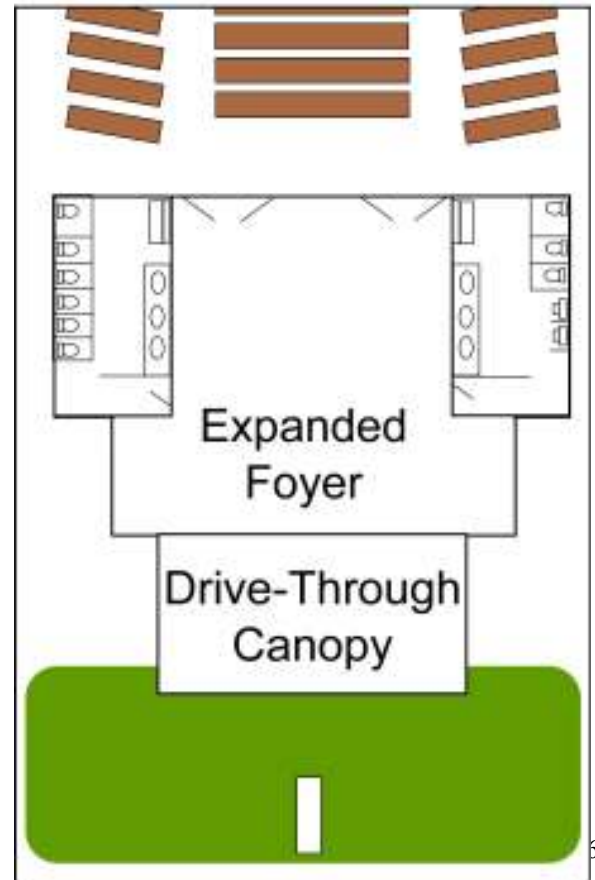
Phase Two will be to make some renovations to the auditorium. We will redesign and build a new platform, which will allow us to reclaim the space in the former choir loft. We also plan to erect walls on each side of the auditorium which will enclose the double doors by the piano and the organ, creating a new entryway on each side. This will allow us to re-open these doors for those who need a handicap entrance, and for those entering the auditorium from the rear building. This will also create a new space for two new media screens located on each side of the auditorium, replacing the single screen in the middle. We will also address the need for new lighting on the inside of the auditorium.



In the vestibule we will address the need for larger, more private, and handicap-accessible restrooms. In order to enlarge the restrooms, we would close in the existing front porch, and make it part of a new lobby. A new drive-through canopy would be added to the front, and designed to blend in with the exterior architecture.

Architects have advised us to budget \$350,000 for Phase Two.

Phase Three is a projected project to build a Family Life Center. This will facilitate a new activity center for our children, youth, and young adults. It will replace the old fellowship hall with a much larger fellowship area, and add additional classroom space.



Our Responsibility...

Not Equal Giving, But Equal Sacrifice

Faith In Action is a 156 week program that begins on Sunday, September 28, 2008. During the next few weeks, each member and friend of the church family will be given the opportunity to promise a specific amount above their regular tithe and offerings. This will require sacrifices on the part of each of us.

To make a commitment to give over and above the regular gifts to the church is a marvelous challenge. It will require a willingness among all the people to sacrifice together.

What should you give? There is just one answer to this question: **A SACRIFICIAL GIFT.**

Our program for giving has one fundamental principle: **NOT EQUAL GIFTS, BUT EQUAL SACRIFICE.** Decisions concerning the amount of the gift, be it Reason Giving, Revelation Giving, or both, will rest solely on the individual or family.

Reason Giving: the lump sum amount we give immediately.

Revelation Giving: the amount we commit ourselves to give over the next three years, trusting God for the supply.

While many of our families will be able to give both an immediate gift as well as a weekly gift, the regular weekly giving is extremely important! It is amazing what the ultimate total is of a gift given systematically over a 156 week period.

After prayerful consideration, our Pastor and the Faith In Action Steering Committee has established three goals:

Faith Goal: \$300,000
Much Faith Goal: \$375,000
Great Faith Goal: \$450,000

“But my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus...” - Philippians 4:19

Our goal is to raise the funds needed for Phases One and Two. Each giving unit equals \$6.50 and totals \$1,014.00 over the next 156 weeks. This is given above our regular tithes. The following chart depicts what can be done through systematic giving.

If you wish to give in honor of someone, or in memory of a loved one, we will present you with a certificate as well as the engraved plaque, both to keep as family heirlooms. This will give you a unique opportunity to honor or memorialize someone who has been very special to you. This will serve as a testimony of your love for your church and that special someone in your life.
